Birmingham Manufacturing Facility Operations Resumption

Dear Valued PETNET Customer,

We are pleased to inform you that the City of Birmingham lifted the evacuation orders affecting our Birmingham manufacturing facility this week. Following the lifting of the order, PETNET conducted a thorough assessment of the facility, equipment, and critical systems to ensure the site could safely resume operations.

Based on the results of this assessment, we have confirmed that conditions within the facility are safe for employees to return and for manufacturing activities to resume. As a result, we will **return to normal operations and product production beginning July 31, 2026.**

We appreciate your patience and understanding during this unexpected disruption. Throughout this event, our highest priorities were the safety of our employees, the integrity of our operations, and the continuity of care for the patients who depend on our products. We are grateful for the support and collaboration from our customers as we worked through these circumstances.

We also want to thank our teams and partners who helped maintain service continuity through alternative supply arrangements and our SafetyNet network. Their efforts helped minimize disruption while access to the Birmingham facility remained restricted.
